Dear Brothers in Christ -

I continue to labor out-of-bounds at Reformed Theological Seminary in Jackson, as well as serving as pastor of First Presbyterian Church in Yazoo City.

I serve as associate professor of practical theology, dean of students, dean of chapel, director of field education, and faculty advisor for the Student Cabinet and the African American Leadership Initiative.

This year I met with 141 of the 153 students on my care list (281 total visits with students either individually, in groups, or in hospitality events hosted with Lynne). I conducted 48 new student interviews and 33 graduating student exit interviews. My time with students includes personal, marriage, and vocational counseling.

Lynne and I host students in our home, including a monthly book club for students and spouses. Lynne serves a meal, and discussion of the book follows. Lynne has helped female students host gatherings that I have not attended and meets with female students and spouses when requested. She prepares meals for student families who have needs because of the birth of a child, job related stresses, or poor health.

I work with students to prepare them for the pastoral search process and to ensure their understanding of the manners and etiquette expected of gospel ministers. Chapel services are a time to model a reverent approach to worship, ministry, and pastoral care.

Lynne and I love working at RTS.

Thank you, brothers, for praying for RTS and for me. I cherish our fellowship in the Lord and partnership in the gospel.
