I have continued, in the past year, in the work to which this presbytery has called and ordained me.

The following is a report of my labors since the August 2014 stated meeting of this presbytery.

Service at Reformed Theological Seminary

I have taught a full load of courses in the Fall and Spring Semesters of Academic Year 2014-2015. These courses included both core and elective courses.

I continue to direct the DMin program on the Jackson campus.

I have continued academic advising responsibilities for Seminary students.

Service outside Reformed Theological Seminary

My family and I have faithfully attended morning and evening services on the Lord's Day at First Presbyterian Church, Jackson. For three months of this year, I was regularly engaged in weekly Sunday School instruction for an adult class at First Presbyterian Church, Jackson.

I have also preached 56 times in congregations of this presbytery, other PCA presbyteries, and outside the PCA. On 10 occasions, I administered the Lord's Supper; on one occasion, I administered baptism. On at least 51 occasions, I pronounced the benediction. On four occasions, I was part of a presbytery commission to ordain and install a man to gospel ministry.

From May, 2014 - January, 2015, I served as stated supply of the Second Presbyterian Church, Yazoo City, MS.

This past February, my EP Study Commentary on Acts was released, and in March, the revised *Reformation Study Bible* was released (I was one of the New Testament editors). I also drafted three chapters for two forthcoming books; a journal article; and several book reviews. I am in the process of beginning to draft a book on the doctrine of Scripture.

In May, 2015, I taught a course on Pauline Theology for the Association of Reformed Baptist Churches of Quebec in St. Jerome, Quebec, Canada.

In July, 2015, I taught DM 801, "The Doctrine of Justification" for Ligonier Academy.

In July, 2015, I taught “A Biblical Theology of Covenant” at the Presbyterian Theological College, Melbourne, VIC, Australia.

In June, 2015, I attended General Assembly as a commissioner. I have served this past year as an alternate the Assembly’s Theological Examining Committee. This year, I was elected as a member of this committee.

Service in Mississippi Valley Presbytery

I have faithfully attended all stated and called meetings of this presbytery during this period.

I am now serving on MVP’s Credentials and Nominations Committees. I presently chair the Nominations Committee.

Conclusions and Petition for Extension of OOB Status

2014-2015 has been an eventful year. I am grateful for the opportunity to have undertaken this work that this presbytery has called and ordained me to do. I do wish to report a change in my call. My base salary has increased 2%. My housing allowance remains unchanged. I am grateful for Mississippi Valley Presbytery’s permission to have labored Out of Bounds this past year. I respectfully request that Mississippi Valley Presbytery grant me permission to labor out of bounds as Professor of New Testament, Reformed Theological Seminary, Jackson, MS.
