In the past year, I have continued in the work to which this presbytery has called me, and the following is a report of my labors since the stated meeting of the presbytery in August 2015.

Service at Reformed Theological Seminary

I have taught a full load of courses in the Fall and Spring semesters of 2015-2016. I also taught a course at the RTS Memphis campus in the Fall semester.

I have also been consistently involved in advising and counseling seminary students.

Service outside of Reformed Theological Seminary

My family and I attended First Presbyterian Church, Jackson, when I was not preaching elsewhere.

I have preached around 40 times in congregations of this presbytery and other PCA presbyteries. On 4 occasions I administered the Lord's Supper; on one occasion, I administered baptism.

From February 2015 – October 2015, I served as stated supply of the Second Presbyterian Church, Yazoo City, MS.

In the Fall 2015 edition of the RTS magazine *Ministry and Leadership*, my article "The Lord is My Portion" was published.

In November 2015, I moderated the invited session of the Psalms and Hebrew Poetry section at the Annual Meeting of the Evangelical Theological Society. I also presented a paper on Psalm 118 at an Institute for Biblical Research session at the Annual Meeting of the Society of Biblical Literature.

In December 2015, I was elected to the steering committee of the Psalms and Hebrew Poetry section of the Evangelical Theological Society.

In February 2016, I spoke twice at the Valentine's Banquet at Westminster Presbyterian Church in Vicksburg.

In May 2016, *A Biblical Theological Introduction to the Old Testament* was released by Crossway in which I wrote three chapters.

I have also written several publications that are scheduled to be published within the coming year.

Serving in Presbytery of the Mississippi Valley

I am serving on the Campus Committee.

Conclusions and Petition for Extension of OOB Status

I am thankful for serving in the capacity to which this presbytery has called me. I do not wish to report a change in my call. My base salary has increased 2%. My housing allowance remains unchanged. I am grateful for the presbytery receiving me into membership in May 2015 and permitting me to serve out of bounds over the past year. I respectfully request that the Presbytery of the Mississippi Valley grant me person to labor out of bounds as Assistant Professor of Old Testament, Reformed Theological Seminary, Jackson, MS.
