

Annual Report of Paul Nasckos to the Presbytery of the Mississippi Valley for 2013

Dear Fathers and Brothers in Christ,

I continue to be grateful for the permission of The Presbytery of Mississippi Valley to labor out of bounds as the director for the Greater Jackson Area Chapter of Child Evangelism Fellowship. I respectfully request permission to continue to serve this ministry as the Lord enables me for the coming year.

A number of churches mentioned in this report, including this presbytery, are supporting my ministry and/or contributing to the general fund of the chapter. The friendship of the saints and their fellowship in the gospel ministry are treasured blessings and I count it an honor to be serving the wider church with the glorious gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.

I have preached, taught, or spoken at FPC Gulfport, FPC Belzoni, FPC Demopolis, AL, North Park PC, Pear Orchard Presbyterian, Trinity Presbyterian, RTS Chapel, First Baptist Madison, Antioch Baptist Pearl, Voice of Calvary Fellowship, and Bethsaida Baptist, French Camp, MS. I have administered the Lord's Supper and conducted a memorial service.

This past spring I taught the Children's Ministry Institute course called Teaching Children Effectively, Level 1, a 30 hour college level course. I have trained over 100 individuals from various evangelical churches to teach God's Word to boys and girls.

Also, I participated in the State Leadership Conference and the Board/Committee Enrichment Conference at CEF International Headquarters in Warrenton, MO. Each month I meet with pastors to promote the need for taking the gospel to the tens of thousands of children in metro Jackson who do not know God or His gospel.

It has been my privilege to coordinate over 100 individuals on various teams from Highlands Presbyterian, North Park Presbyterian, St. Paul Presbyterian, Colonial Heights Baptist, Alta Woods Baptist, Grace Bible Baptist, Pear Orchard Presbyterian, Lakeland Presbyterian, Trinity Presbyterian, Providence Presbyterian, First Presbyterian Jackson, Riverwood Bible churches, Antioch Baptist, First Baptist Madison. These saints are conducting Good News Clubs during the school year in locations such as Lester Elementary, George Elementary, McLeod Elementary, Lower Elementary Pearl, I. S. Sanders YMCA, Reservoir YMCA, Clinton YMCA, the Boys and Girls Clubs of Central Mississippi (various locations) and numerous child care centers around the Metro Jackson area.

Each summer I am one of the teacher/trainers for our student missionary program called Christian Youth in Action (CYIA). For this program, during a one week intensive training camp in June we train junior high, senior high, college students and adults to teach 5-Day Clubs in the metro area and now in cities statewide. We conduct dozens of 5-Day Clubs (5-DC), which are 1½ hour Bible clubs that meet daily for five days, over a six week period for more than 1,000 boys and girls throughout Hinds, Madison, and Rankin counties.

Each October, I administer our evangelistic outreach at the Mississippi State Fair through the Good News Tent. About 40 area evangelical churches have members coming to proclaim Christ to around 2000 fairgoers in the tent.

All the glory goes to our mighty God for allowing us to take the gospel to thousands of children and adults this past year. We pray that the Holy Spirit will seal the saving grace of God to the souls of those who have prayed to receive Christ as well as the many more who have heard the Word of Life.

Your financial support and prayers are deeply appreciated as I continue to serve our Lord in the huge mission fields all around the churches of the Tri-County Area. Also, please pray for favor as I meet with pastors and congregations to appeal to them to awaken to the cries of a lost generation in a godless culture in need of the justifying grace of Jesus Christ.
