WHEREAS RE Barrett was a long-time member of the Macon Presbyterian Church (PCA), serving as both a Deacon and Ruling Elder for many years, and serving as the Stated Clerk of the Session for six years; and,

WHEREAS RE Barrett exemplified service in many ways, including four years of service in the Air Force during World War II; working as the Superintendent of Education for Noxubee County Schools for 10 years, the Noxubee County Election Commissioner for 15 years, the Noxubee County Democratic Party Executive Commissioner for 17 years; and, serving as City of Macon Alderman for 4 terms; and,

WHEREAS RE Barrett received numerous civic honors including Noxubee County Chamber of Commerce Man of the Year and Lions Club Lion of the Year; and,



UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED by the Session of the Macon Presbyterian Church (PCA) at its stated meeting on September 3, 2007.




