

**RESOLUTION IN MEMORIAM
OF DONALD G. BREAZEALE**

The unexpected passing of Donald Glenn Breazeale on November 12, 2015 was one of those teachable moments in which the Lord emphasizes the frailty of life and the necessity of a personal relationship with our Savior Jesus Christ. Don was a man of wisdom, good cheer and obvious contentment. His life reminds us of the Apostle Paul's letter to Timothy: "But Godliness actually is a means of great gain when accompanied by contentment". (1 Tim 6:6, NAS). Don was a man of joyful contentment.

We therefore honor Donald Glenn Breazeale as follows:

WHEREAS, Don was born in Grenada, MS, on May 31, 1952, but spent his childhood in McComb, later graduated from Murrah High School in 1970, and attended the University of Mississippi where he was a member of Phi Delta Theta Fraternity; and

WHEREAS, Don developed a sophisticated level of expertise in financial planning and was one of the founders of KTB Wealth Partners, where he had a long career dedicated to clients and their financial planning; and

WHEREAS, Don served First Presbyterian Church of Jackson in many capacities having been ordained as a Deacon on July 31, 1988 and installed as a Ruling Elder on January 5, 1997; and

WHEREAS, Don served as a devoted member of the Reformed Theological Seminary Board of Trustees and as a member of its Executive Committee; and

WHEREAS, although he served in other civic capacities, Don had a special interest in Jackson Academy where he served on numerous committees and was a longtime member of the Jackson Academy Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, Don was preceded in death by his first wife, Missye Rhee, by his parents, Pearl and Forest Breazeale but is survived by his wife, Betsy Ann, his children, Glenn Breazeale, Maury Breazeale and Marianna Shaw, his step-children and nine grandchildren; and


