A RESOLUTION BY THE SESSION OF THE FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH MEMORIALIZING THE LIFE OF JUNIUS W. BROWN.

WHEREAS, God in His infinite wisdom on 9/22/89 called forth Junius W. Brown from his earthly tabernacle to his heavenly reward;

WHEREAS, Junius W. Brown served the Lord and the congregation of First Presbyterian Church, Belzoni, Mississippi, as a deacon from 8/9/31 to 12/19/43;

WHEREAS, on 12/19/43, Junius W. Brown was elected as an Elder of First Presbyterian Church and served in this position continuously from said time until his death on 9/22/89;

WHEREAS, he epitomized Christian virtues by his humble, genteel demeanor, high moral character and virtues, and strong Christian faith in our Lord, Jesus Christ;

WHEREAS, in time of adversity his faith never wavered but indeed became stronger, setting an example for all of us;

Brown, extol his accomplishments and dedication as a member of this Session and extend deepest sympathy to the members of his family, joining with them in feeling the great loss now that he is no longer with us.
