WHEREAS, our beloved Elder served as Moderator of Mississippi Valley Presbytery at its regular stated meeting in Nineteen Hundred Seventy Nine and at a called meeting in Kosciusko, Mississippi, completing his service in February of Nineteen Hundred Eighty,

WHEREAS, our dear friend was instrumental in starting a Prayer Breakfast at the Naval Air Station, Meridian, Mississippi and faithfully attended same as long as he was physically able,
