
WHEREAS, Henry's professional and courtly demeanor, generosity, and benevolence were well known in Louisville and Winston County;

WHEREAS, he was a devoted member of Rotary International, having served in many capacities, including President of the Louisville Rotary Club and a District Governor of Rotary;


