

**James Buchanan Hutton III**  
**January 20, 1940 – October 13, 2010**  
**Mississippi Valley Presbytery**

Whereas, on October 13, 2010, James Buchanan “Jim” Hutton III was suddenly ushered into the presence of the Lord Jesus, the only Savior of God’s elect, and

Whereas, Jim having faithfully served the Lord from the day of his conversion until the day of his death, it seems fit to the Session of Tchula Presbyterian Church to call attention to the Lord’s great mercy to RE Jim Hutton in his life and service, and

Whereas Jim was born on January 20, 1940, in Lexington, MS, the son of Samuel Donnell Gwin Hutton and Mary Louise Irvine Hutton, and lived his three score and 10 years in Holmes county, and

Whereas Jim graduated from Tchula High School in 1957, graduated from Holmes Junior College, and then graduated from Mississippi State University in 1962 with a degree in Agricultural Education, and

Whereas Jim, after graduating from college, enlisted in the Army National Guard and was stationed at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, and

Whereas Jim married Louise Elliott on November 24, 1965, and raised three covenant children, James B. Hutton IV, Robert Elliott Hutton, and William Dobyns Hutton, teaching them the Catechism of the Presbyterian faith, and having them baptized as infants at Tchula Presbyterian Church, and

Whereas Jim was admitted to communicant membership at Tchula Presbyterian Church by profession of faith on September 3, 1950, was ordained a Ruling Elder on July 11, 1976, and served in that calling for 34 years, and


Whereas Jim taught the young people’s Sunday School class, instructing his grandsons, faithfully attended Wednesday prayer meeting, led morning and evening worship services during interim pastorates, and served on the Shepherding and Advisory Committee of Mississippi Valley Presbytery, and

Whereas Jim loved and taught the doctrines of grace with fervor and with the determination that God receive all the glory for the salvation of His elect,

Be it therefore resolved that the hope of Tchula Presbyterian Church is that all who benefitted from Jim’s charge will worship God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit, with sincerity and truth, as found in the pages of Holy Scripture, and

Be it therefore resolved that this memorial of RE James Buchanan Hutton III be included in the session minutes of Tchula Presbyterian Church and presented at the meeting of Mississippi Valley Presbytery on February 7, 2012, and that copies be sent to his wife, Louise, and to his three sons.
