

*Memorial Resolution
from the Westminster Presbyterian Church, Vicksburg, Ms
concerning
John Thomas Moore
who died April 23, 1992*

Whereas, God comforts us with the assurance that the death of his saints is precious in his sight and the death of John Thomas Moore happened by God's sovereign good pleasure on April 23, 1992; and

Whereas, John Thomas Moore used his God-given talents as a devoted member of Westminster Presbyterian Church since 1955, serving as a choir member, Deacon, Treasurer of the Church for more than 30 years, Elder since 1972, and Elder Emeritus since 1988; and

Whereas, he retired as Assistant Comptroller and Chief of Management Branch of the Mississippi River Commission, and after retirement, he worked in the business office at Mercy Regional Medical Center, and always lived a consistent Christian life and showed concern for his community; and

Whereas, he faithfully loved his lifelong friend and wife, Viola Ruth Holderfield Moore, for 56 years, raising with her help a son, James G. Moore - setting before him a godly example and nurturing him in the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Now, therefore, be it resolved "That the Session of Westminster Presbyterian Church express to the Maker of Heaven and Earth, the Lord of the Church, and to the Holy Spirit their thanks for the life and witness of John Thomas Moore and for allowing him to serve in our community and in our church."

Be it further resolved "That this resolution be spread upon the Minutes of this Session, and that a copy be sent to his wife, Ruth, and son, James, and that a copy be sent to the Mississippi Valley Presbytery that John Thomas Moore might be memorialized at the June 1992 meeting of the Presbytery."
