

*Memorial Resolution
from the Westminster Presbyterian Church, Vicksburg, Ms
concerning
Paul Kelly Senter
who died December 26, 1991*

Whereas, our Lord and Master, in His infinite wisdom and love, ended the faithful and fruitful service of his servant, Paul Kelly Senter, in this world of ours and called this talented officer of this church and beloved husband, father, and friend, into even greater and more extensive service in His Kingdom in Heaven; and

Whereas, as this departed servant, an able and devoted member of Westminster Presbyterian Church of Vicksburg since November 1962, served as a scoutmaster, teacher and Deacon, and Elder since December 1976, and Clerk of the Session from 1988-1991, and performed his duties with humility, honor, and devotion in leading his congregation in the work and love of his Father in Heaven; and

Whereas, his outreach for Christ was into the community, as a professional engineer, a member of the American Society of Civil Engineers, serving 29 years with the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, Waterways Experiment Station, Assistant Chief of the Information Technology Laboratory, and a member of Gideons International.

Whereas, his witness of love and service to the Savior, and his commitment to the Word of God served as a personal exhortation and encouragement to those who knew him.

Now, therefore, be it resolved "That the Session of Westminster Presbyterian Church express its thanks to Almighty God for Paul Kelly Senter and for placing him among us to be our friend and to serve our church and community."

And be it further resolved "That this resolution be spread upon the Minutes of this Session, and that a copy be sent to his wife, Sarah, and daughter, Kelly, and that a copy be sent to the Mississippi Valley Presbytery that Paul Kelly Senter might be memorialized at the June 1992 meeting of the Presbytery."
