

RESOLUTION IN MEMORIAM
OF
S. C. WADSWORTH

WHEREAS, S. C. "Shirley" Wadsworth was born on November 14, 1916, in Philadelphia, Mississippi, and subsequently in 1947 moved to Jackson where he became a successful plumbing contractor; and

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of March, 1957, Shirley and his wife Tommye joined First Presbyterian Church and after six years of active membership, Shirley was elected to the office of Deacon on February 3, 1963; and

WHEREAS, having served for four years on the Board of Deacons in various capacities, on March 19, 1967, Shirley was ordained an Elder at First Presbyterian Church, where he labored faithfully for twenty years before being granted Emeritus status on November 2, 1987; and


WHEREAS, during all these years Shirley was active in the Brotherhood Class and in various positions of service within First Presbyterian and in such worthwhile Christian endeavors as the Gideon's International; and


