

## Out of Bounds Report

Fathers and Brothers,

This past year has been busy. I continue to work full time with the Vet Center in Jackson Mississippi. I am out in the state talking with veterans and help connect them with the VA and other resources. I am continuing to get the film Invisible Scars out and give them to veterans. We are developing another film on moral injury called "Honoring the Code." We will be filming it in the next couple months (July through October).

I continue to be the Chairman for the Mission to the Military (MTM) Committee. I had opportunity to speak in churches about the committee and share the three prongs of our work. The three prongs that we focus on are first Chaplains. We want to put qualified men into the system for Chaplains. Second, we want to help plant churches or put reformed men into churches near military bases. Finally, we want to help veterans that return. Anyone who goes to war comes back changed. We, as the church should recognize that and act accordingly. I spoke at Westminster in Vicksburg about our committee and answered any questions they may have. I spoke at Bailey Presbyterian Church on developing an outreach to the military. Finally, I spoke to our Pro's group at Providence about my experience as a Chaplain in Iraq and Afghanistan.

I led a Sunday school class at Providence Presbyterian Church for two quarters on the book of Acts. I also had opportunities to preach at Providences evening services and in their morning service.

I am teaching classes at Belhaven's Aspire program. I taught classes on Old Testament Poets; Old Testament Prophets; World View 301; Kingdom Life Worldview 401; Old Testament History; Paul and His Epistles and will teach a class on Evangelism and Discipleship.

I am involved in Clinton's Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) 3685. We meet at Providence Presbyterian Church the third Thursday of the month. I am the Post Commander. I also continue to be involved in Toastmaster's International at the VA.
