Dear Roger,

Thanks for the reminder about the report as a minster without call serving outside the geographic bounds of the Presbytery of the Mississippi Valley. I continue to serve as the stated supply of the McDonald Presbyterian Church in Collins, MS, within the geographic bounds of Grace Presbytery. I request that the Presbytery of the Mississippi Valley allow me to serve another year out of their geographic bounds as Stated Supply here at the McDonald PCA in Collins, pending the approval of the stated supply relationship by the local Session and Grace Presbytery. I also ask that MVP communicate their decision to Steve Shuman, the clerk of Grace Presbytery (<drsteveshuman@att.net>).

Here in Collins, I am living in the manse, filling the pulpit and pastoring the flock. I have a good relationship with the Session and the congregation. I have been attending the Presbytery meetings of Grace Presbytery as well as those of the Presbytery of the Mississippi Valley.

Since last year, many of my sermons have been in the book of Hebrews and the book of Philippians. I lack one sermon finishing my series on the book of Philippians. After that, I will go back to Hebrews and finish that series. On the first Sunday in each month, I have been preaching a series in the gospel according to Mark.

The church is in the process of electing a new deacon. My wife recently began teaching Sunday school for three young children, and I began teaching an adult Sunday school class. My wife has also been the teacher at the monthly WIC meeting.

In August 2015, we had Dr. David Jussely for a series of five sermons on Isaiah 53, and the church had its yearly VBS in July 2015. Both my wife and I helped with the VBS.

I will soon rotate off the General Assembly Standing Judicial Commission. There was a rather significant case, in my opinion, regarding paedocommunion in 2015. My views on the subject are expressed in a concurring opinion which I submitted together with a Ruling Elder.
